Re: Grantee Codes

As part of the Department of Labor's data collection requirements, all SCSEP grantees are required to track services that SCSEP participants receive from any national, state or set aside grantee. If a participant is transferred from another national or state grantee, he or she will not be included in performance measures (placement, retention and earnings increase) until he or she exits from the SCSEP program. When participants exit from SCSEP, their outcomes will be reflected in the placement and retention performance measures of both grantees.

The list below specifies the grantee codes for every national, state and set aside grantee. The SSAI Participant (Questions #16 and 17) and Exit (Question #6a, ii and iii) forms both contain fields or questions where these codes are needed:

Project Directors or other SCSEP staff do not have to enter this data in SPARQ. All transfers are completed by the SSAI Information Technology Department by using the transfer utility in SPARQ.
